GIZ's University & Hospital Partnerships in Africa and the project "Empowering Women in Health Innovation" (WE Health) are teaming up to support African women in digital health. WE Health aims to enhance the participation of women in health innovation and entrepreneurial activities by providing capacity-building specifically tailored to their needs and by inspiring and supporting them to advance in their professional careers (<http://we.eithealth.eu/>).

The WE Health Capacity Building program is composed of three modules with a different thematic focus area addressing the needs of diverse target groups of women in the healthcare domain. We will support the participation in the following two Modules:

## Module 2 (6-8th July 2020, online):

This module is dedicated to women who want to validate their business idea and address their entrepreneurial challenges. Partner lead: Technical University Munich. Participants should have a business idea in mind or are already working on their own business idea in the field of healthcare and innovation.

## Module 3 (14-16th September 2020, online or f2f):

This module is dedicated to senior female leaders who are leading and driving innovation in different settings and would like to enhance their intrapreneurial skills. Partner lead: IESE Business School. Participants should be female senior executives and innovators in the healthcare sector with at least 10 years of experience.
